Director's Notes

If truth is stranger than fiction, then *Chicago* is a strange musical. The characters of Roxie Hart and Velma Kelly are based on real-life counterparts. In 1924, Beulah Annan (Roxie) was accused of killing an intruder, Harry Kalstedt, and Belva Gaertner (Velma) was charged with murdering her husband. *Chicago Tribune* reporter Maurine Watkins covered their stories with front page news, her articles including details of a supposed pregnancy, a slick lawyer, early trial dates, and a double acquittal. Riding the success of her reporting, Watkins wrote a comedy by the same name, *Chicago*, which reached Broadway in 1926. A feature film soon followed, and several years later a second film aptly named *Roxie Hart* and starring Ginger Rogers was released.

The story ended there until June 3, 1975, when the show reopened at the 46th Street Theater, featuring Gwen Verdon, Chita Rivera, and Jerry Orbach in the lead roles. Although the production was nominated for eleven Tony Awards, it won none, losing out on all counts to *A Chorus Line* which opened the same year.

Chicago again lay dormant until November 14, 1996 when its revival at the Richard Rodgers Theater on Broadway garnered six Tony Awards, including Best Revival. In December, 2002 yet another film starring Catherine Zeta-Jones, Richard Gere, and Renee Zellweger hit the silver screen. Since its third incarnation *Chicago* hasn't looked back. On December 27, 2007, the Broadway production welcomed its five millionth audience member.

Following its national success, *Chicago* has become an international phenomenon. Since 2002 alone the show has been translated into ten languages and has been staged in England, Sweden, Denmark, South Korea, Dubai, Japan, Portugal, Argentina, Russia, Italy, South Africa, and Spain.

For me, anyway, it is difficult to watch *Chicago* and not think about F. Scott Fitzgerald's classic novel *The Great Gatsby* and the failed American Dream. The excesses of that decade of the Twenties, the greed and corruption and the larger-than-life characters, perhaps explain why *Chicago* enjoyed such success in the Nineties, another decade of excess. Given its razor thin line between stardom and infamy, between entertainment and real life, *Chicago* seems almost to be a parody of our times where media spin is often all that matters.
